

Packing list for a South African Safari

Thornybush

Light, neutral coloured clothing: In general, it is a good idea to pack comfortable, casual clothing that you can wash and wear easily. Go with clothes that are lightweight and airy as it can become incredibly hot when the sun is beating down.

Neutral colours such as khaki, green, beige, light browns, neutral checks and even light to medium blues are best for game viewing. To avoid looking like a safari novice, steer clear of bright red, yellow, purple and white (white also gets dirty quickly which can happen easily in the bush).

Sun protection: sunscreen, sunglasses, hat, and lip balm



Comfortable walking shoes



Binoculars



Camera, lenses, extra batteries and memory cards



A personal medical kit



Something slightly snazzy for lodge and/or hotel dinners
